Macedon Ranges Wildlife Network is a group of local wildlife rescuers and wildlife shelters that came together in 2007 to respond to the increasing number of wildlife emergencies in the local region. We are all volunteers.

There are so many ways you can help wildlife, from making your fences wildlife friendly, to putting out water on hot days, to sewing pouches for orphaned joeys.

How demanding is the work of the MRWN?

Between 2014 and 2017, there were on average 1720 calls outs each year. In that period, 4,835 were to kangaroos, and 108 koalas. Wallabies and echidnas are also sadly other high casualties.

NOTICE OF REVISION OF PARISH ELECTORAL ROLL Parish of Gisborne

The parish electoral roll of this parish will be revised by the parish electoral committee commencing on September 24th, 2020 and applications for enrolment will close on Friday 16th October, 2020.

The Parish Governance Act 2013 provides that parish electoral roll is to contain the names of people who are of at least eighteen years of age and who—

- (a) are baptised;
- (b) regularly and habitually attend public worship at a worship centre in the parish;
- (c) have signed an application seeking to be included on the roll and declaring that—
 - (i) they are a member of the Anglican Church of Australia or of a church in communion with the Anglican Church of Australia;
 - (ii) they are not a member of any church which is not in communion with the Anglican Church of Australia; and
 - (iii) they are not on the parish electoral roll of any other parish or any Authorised Anglican Congregation in the Diocese other than a roll from which they wish their name to be removed.

The parish electoral roll as revised will be displayed 14 days prior to the annual meeting. A person must be on the parish electoral roll to vote at the annual meeting.


